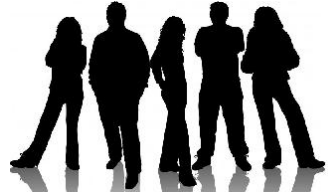

ETHIOPIAN ADULT BIBLE / (18 – and older) Rm. 201

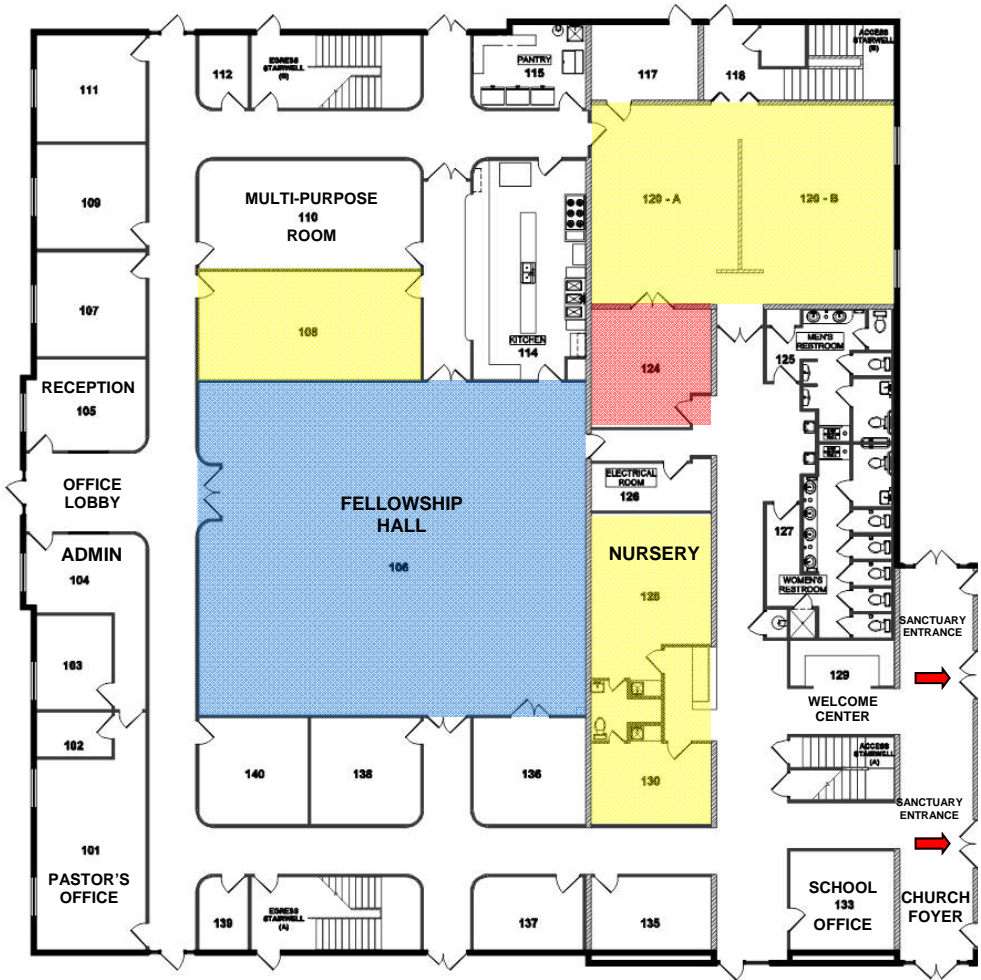



1ST FLOOR


